WHEREAS the overall use of illicit drugs requiring needles is on the rise in Greater Sudbury, as well as across the province;

AND WHEREAS the needle exchange program offered by the Sudbury and District Health Unit has seen a significant rise in use in the last 3 years, with as many as 800,000 needles in 2016;

AND WHEREAS the City of Greater Sudbury has received increased complaints and concerns in regards to finding used needles in public places from residents, parks and recreation staff as well other agencies across the City, resulting in public safety concerns for everyone in Greater Sudbury;

AND WHEREAS the City of Greater has installed bio bins in various public locations across the City to assist with the disposal of used needles to enhance public safety, but additional action is required to help mitigate this safety concern;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City of Greater Sudbury direct City Staff to perform the following:

- #1 provide onetime funding as an unbudgeted expenditure in the amount of \$12,000.00 to assist with increased used/dirty needle pick up and cleanup effective immediately until December 31<sup>st</sup> 2017; and
- #2 ensure that the cleanup program be conducted in partnership with Sudbury Action Center for Youth (SACY) on a single source and interim basis until Dec 31<sup>st</sup> 2017, and that efficacy and outcome measurements be performed by City staff during this period; and
- #3 prepare a business case for the 2018 budget process that would see additional pick up and cleanup of used/dirty needles continued.
