The following recommendation was referred to the February 10, 2015 City Council meeting in order for Infrastructure Services to provide timelines, success' of the 2015 LED Conversion Project as well as soft costs for the hiring of a project manager.

OP2015-03: Landry-Altmann/Dutrisaac: THAT the City of Greater Sudbury provide authority to the General Manager of Infrastructure Services to complete retrofits of all C.G.S. streetlights, subject to a positive business case, as outlined in the report dated January 28, 2015 from the General Manager of Infrastructure Services;

AND THAT, it is a multi-year program with locations determined by the General Manager of Infrastructure Services;

AND THAT, preliminary estimates to Finance this project in the amounts of \$4 million in 2015, \$2 million in 2016, and \$2 million in 2017 be provided from the Capital Financing Reserve Fund - Roads;

AND THAT, savings from the project be credited back to the Capital Financing Reserve Fund - Roads until the capital investment has been reached:

AND THAT, staff report back to Operations Committee annually on the progress of the LED Streetlight conversion program.
