R-1 . Report dated October 31, 2012 was received from the General Manager of Infrastructure Services regarding Traffic Control - (1) Spruce Meadow Subdivision, Phases 5A & 5B (2) Copper Park Subdivision, Phase 9.

The following recommendation was presented:

OP2012-63 Kett/Caldarelli: THAT the City of Greater Sudbury approve that traffic at the intersection of Country Club Drive and Zina Street be controlled with a Yield sign facing westbound traffic on Zina Street;

AND THAT traffic at the intersection of Fleetwood Drive and Zina Street be controlled with a Yield sign facing eastbound traffic on Zina Street;

AND THAT traffic at the intersection of Sapphire Court and Palladium Place be controlled with a Yield sign facing eastbound traffic on Palladium Place;

AND THAT traffic at the intersection of Palladium Place and Topaz Court be controlled with a Yield sign facing eastbound traffic on Topaz Court;

AND THAT a by-law be passed to amend Traffic and Parking By-Law 2010-1 in the City of Greater Sudbury to implement the recommended changes in accordance with the report dated October 31, 2012 from the General Manager of Infrastructure Services.
