We would like to express our opposition to the proposed plan to build the Extendicare on Nottingham Drive. The need for a Seniors home is enormous and we support new such homes. The location however and proposed size is disruptive to the residential neighbourhood for which this proposal is indicated. The Seniors home should be placed in a similar location to St. Gabriels in Chelmsford where there is NO disruption to the quiet neighbourhood in this proposal.

We purposely purchased our property over 21 years ago because it was quiet and peaceful. Looked for a place to enjoy nature and with low traffic, no noise and peaceful nights and weekends. Such a proposed site at the end of my street will disrupt forever this neighbourhood. Are there not environmental problems with the Ramsey Lake watershed as well when you consider the amount of water and waste water from such a proposal being only a few hundred meters from Ramsey Lake ( our drinking water ). Plus how many people and residents will be coming and going down our small neighbourhood and I heard 3 shifts? This will keep us awake and will be 365 days a year. Not a good idea in a residential neighbourhood, ambulances, food and service trucks, visitors, staff.....all too much traffic and noise.

**Please do NOT read this at the June 14th meeting,** I just want to go on record as being opposed and in opposition to the site of the Extendicare and not the project.
