


Floor Plan

STUDIO PARTNER

- Willing to invest time and money
- Commitment to purpose-built studio rather than retrofit facility
- Land available in appropriately zoned non-residential area with room to expand

PROFESSIONAL ADVICE:

- Greater Sudbury Development Corporation funded consultants with necessary expertise
- Canadian Entertainment Investors Management hired

FOCUS GROUP:

- Recruited 4 industry professionals with extensive experience in studio usage,
 as frequent large scale production tenants
- Informed developer and architect on preliminary design for FPS and estimate of production costs
