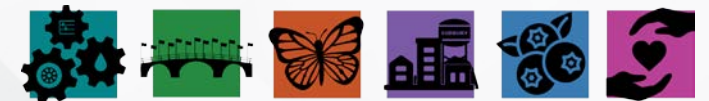

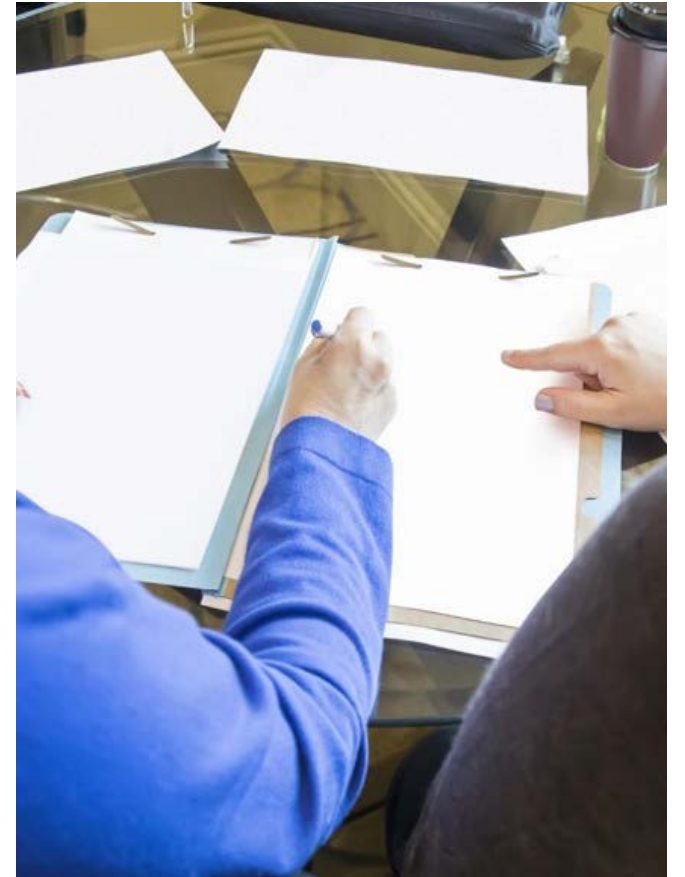

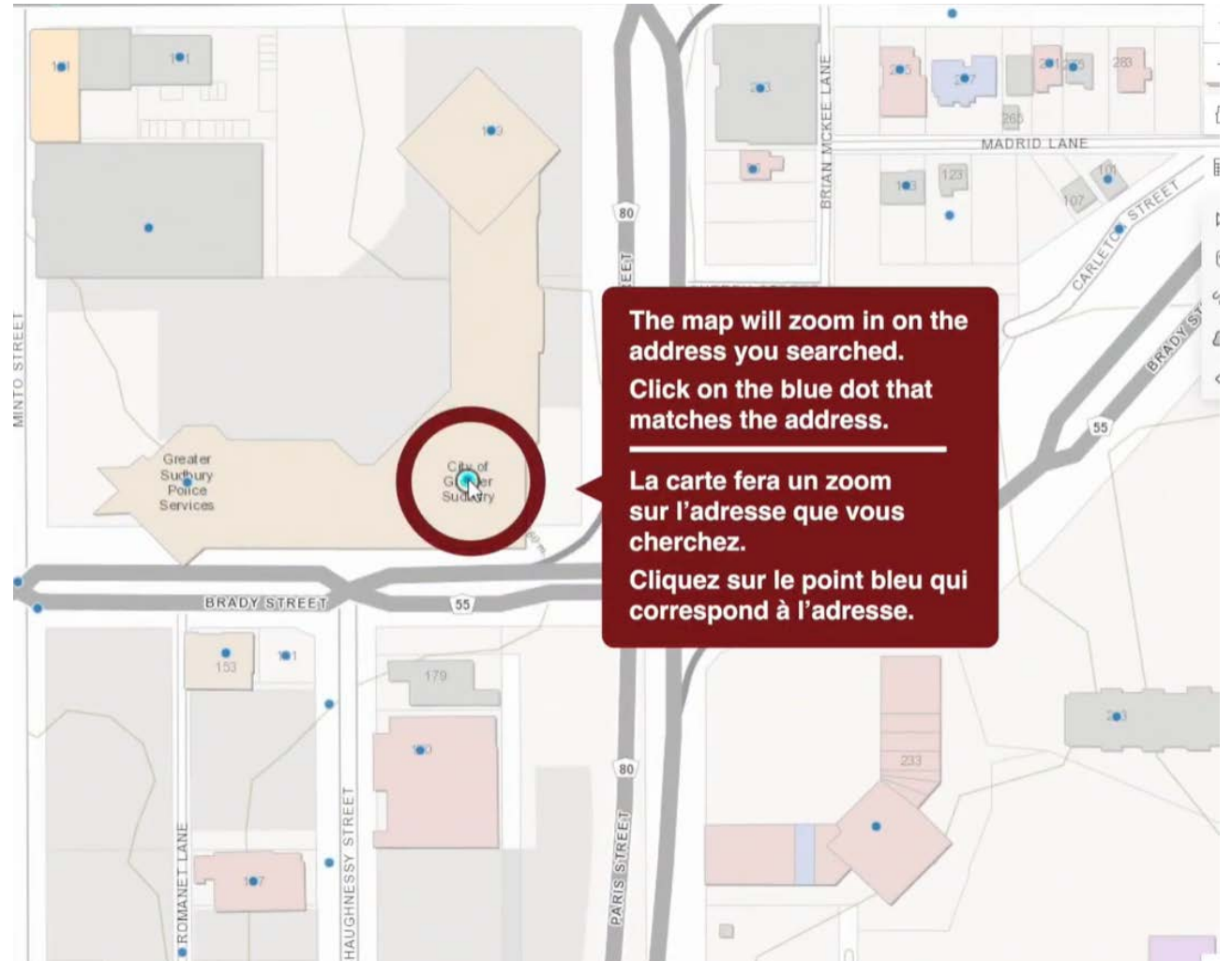


Once you reach the webpage...
