

What is your main reason for using sidewalks in winter?








What time of day do you most use sidewalks in winter? (choose one)






When do you most experience the above difficult conditions?




Were you aware that the City has an Active Transportation Winter Maintenance Policy?



When it comes to increasing sidewalk service levels, which of the following would you be willing to consider? Check all that apply.




Question options


