Resolution

THAT the City of Greater Sudbury appoints Councillor Cormier to the Downtown Sudbury Business Improvement Area (BIA) Board of Management for the remainder of the term 2019-2022.

Background

City Council appointed Councillor McCausland to the Board of Management for the Downtown Sudbury Business Improvement Area ("BIA"). The By-law which established the BIA permits the appointment of two (2) members of Council to the Board.

The Downtown Sudbury BIA Board of Management is recommending that Councillor Cormier be appointed to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the term 2019-2022 (see attached letter). Councillor Cormier has agreed to be appointed to the Board for the remainder of the term.

Selection

In the event that any other member of Council also wish to be appointed to the Board, the selection is to be conducted in accordance with Article 29.07 of the Procedure By-law.
