Relationship to the Strategic Plan, Health Impact Assessment and Community Energy & Emissions Plan (CEEP)

This report refers to Asset Management and Service Excellence as well as Climate Change goals as outlined in the 2019-2027 Strategic Plan adopted by City Council as well as goal # 6 “Achieve 90% solid waste diversion by 2050” in the Community Energy & Emissions Plan (CEEP).

Background

Dillon Consulting has been retained for the purpose of updating the Solid Waste Management Master Plan which has been named the Sustainable Waste Strategy. The plan development is divided into four phases:

- 1) Assess the current state - completed
- 2) Envision the future state - completed
- 3) Determine how to move from the current to future state – Options, goals and performance measurement - completed
- 4) Development of a 10-year Solid Waste Management Master Plan – in progress

The report attached as Appendix A supports Dillon Consulting’s presentation. It provides a consolidated summary of options that are recommended to successfully move the City’s waste management system from the current state to the future state. The Phase 3 report will inform development of a 10-year Sustainable Waste Strategy in the fourth and last phase of the plan.
