

## **BY-LAW 2003-102F**

## A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY TO ESTABLISH A NEW MULTI-RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY CLASS FOR TAXATION PURPOSES

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury pursuant to the Assessment Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.a.31, as amended, is authorized to adopt by By-law optional property classes;

## NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The optional property class, "new multi-residential" as defined in the *Assessment Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.a. 31 and regulations thereunder, shall apply within the City of Greater Sudbury for the 2003 taxation year and thereafter.
- 2. The new multi-residential property class consists of land that would otherwise be in the multi-residential property class, but that the units on the land have been built or converted from a non-residential use pursuant to a building permit issued after April 24, 2003.
- 3. Land ceases to be included in the new multi-residential property class after it has been classified in that class for 35 taxation years.
- **4.** This By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the final passing thereof.
