

By-law 2016-179

**A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Amend By-law 2009-178
being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Set Out
Interpretive Provisions Applying to All By-Laws of the City of Greater Sudbury**

Whereas the City of Greater Sudbury has implemented certain organizational changes which include re-allocation of certain administrative roles and responsibilities and changes in position titles;

And Whereas to avoid confusion in the interpretation of By-laws passed prior to the effective date of the re-organization and in the interpretation of Agreements entered prior to the effective date of the re-organization, Council of the City of Greater Sudbury wishes to amend By-law 2009-178, as amended, being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Set Out Interpretive Provisions Applying to All By-Laws of the City of Greater Sudbury, to reflect the organizational changes;

Now therefore the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

1. By-law 2009-178 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Set Out Interpretive Provisions Applying to All By-Laws of the City of Greater Sudbury, as amended, is hereby further amended to add the following section 14E immediately after section 14D and before section 15:


"14E. Effective September 6th, 2016, in all By-laws of the City of Greater Sudbury and all agreements entered into by the City:

- (a) references to the General Manager of Health and Social Services shall be deemed to be references to the General Manager of Community Development;
- (b) references to the General Manager of Assets, Community and Leisure Services shall be deemed to be:
 - (i) references to the General Manager of Community Development in the case of matters pertaining to the divisions known as Citizen Services and Library and Heritage Resources; and


- (ii) references to the General Manager of Assets, Transit and Fleet Services, in the case of matters pertaining to the divisions known as Asset Services and Transit and Fleet Services.

- 2. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon passage.
