Parking Restrictions - Panache North Shore Road, Walden

### **Resolution**

THAT the City of Greater Sudbury prohibits parking on the south side of Panache North Shore Road from Panache Lake Road to 500 metres west of Panache Lake Road;

AND THAT a by-law be prepared to amend Traffic and Parking By-Law 2010-1 in the City of Greater Sudbury to implement the recommended changes in accordance with the report from the General Manager of Infrastructure Services dated July 15, 2016.

# **Background**

Roads and Transportation Services staff received a request from area residents to restrict parking on Panache North Shore Road due to the difficulties they were having travelling on the road and accessing the waste transfer site when vehicles are parked on both sides of the road.

Panache North Shore Road is located at the south end of Panache Lake Road (Municipal Road 10) in the former Town of Walden (see Exhibit A). This gravel rural roadway has an operating width of approximately six (6) metres. Currently parking is allowed on both sides of the roadway.

On the east side of Panache Lake Road and opposite Panache North Shore Road is the Penage Bay Marina. The marina charges for parking and as a result users of the marina are parking their vehicles and trailers on both sides of Panache North Shore Road.

The primary function of a public road is for the safe and efficient movement of traffic. On-street parking is usually permitted when this criteria is met. Due to the width of Panache North Shore Road, when vehicles are parked on both sides of the road it becomes difficult for area residents to drive on the road and restricts access to abutting properties and the waste transfer site.

To improve safety, it is recommended that parking be prohibited at all times along the south side of Panache North Shore Road from Panache Lake Road to 500 metres west of Panache Lake Road. Councillor Vagnini has indicated his support for this recommendation.
