The City provides grants through Growth and Development; Assets, Citizen and Leisure Services; Health, Social and Emergency Services, and Corporate Revenues Departments.

Executive Summary

At the Finance and Administration Committee meeting held on July 7, 2015, Councilor Landry-Altmann requested that a detailed report be presented during the upcoming 2016 budget deliberations regarding grant allocations to community groups. The information requested was to include the total grant allocation(s), donations and gifts in kind, membership growth,
