Background

This report sets out the procedure for the election by the Committee of the Chair and Vice-Chair of the Community Services Committee for the term ending December 31, 2016.

The Procedure By-law provides that a Member of the Committee shall be appointed annually by the Committee to serve as Chair of the Community Services Committee. As well, a Vice-Chair is appointed annually.

The above appointments need only be confirmed by resolution.

Remuneration

The Chair of the Community Services Committee is paid \$2,043.26 per annum.

Selection

The selection of the Chair and Vice-Chair is to be conducted in accordance with Article 45 of the Procedure By-law.

Council's procedure requires that in the event more than one (1) candidate is nominated for either

the Chair or Vice-Chair's position, a simultaneous recorded vote shall be used to select the Chair and Vice-Chair.

It is always in order for a Member of Council to nominate themselves and to vote for themselves. Under *Robert's Rules of Order* a nomination does not need a second.

Once the successful candidates have been selected, a recommendation will be introduced.
