

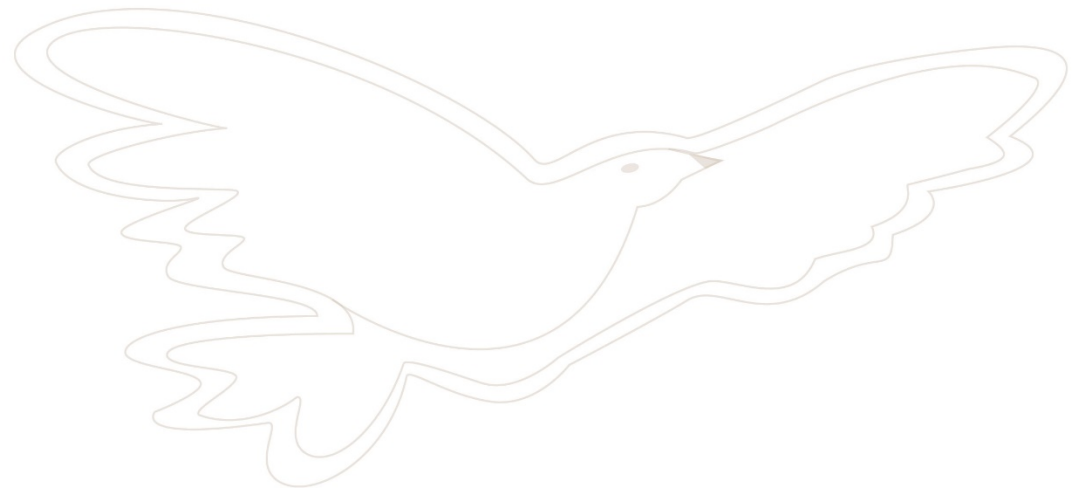

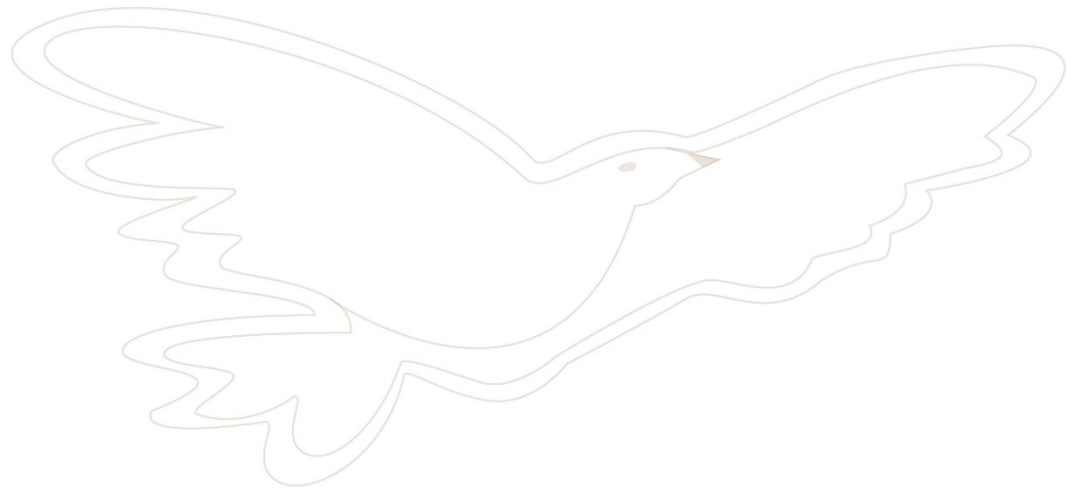
Tullio Ricci Profile

Tullio Ricci served as a City Councillor for the Town of Capreol for 17 years. While in politics, he consistently sought the development of housing and services in the Capreol Community. Tullio was the driving force behind the development of the Capreol Non-Profit Housing – Phase 1 and the Capreol Non-Profit Housing – Phase 2 which consist of 40 units for Senior's with, RGI (rent geared to income) and affordable housing. Tullio continues to work closely with the management of these two complexes to assure their ongoing sustained viability.



Tullio has resided in Capreol for 60 years. For 40 years he was employed by the Canadian National Railway (CNR) in various management capacities. For 10 years Tullio was Chief of Fire Prevention Bureau, President of the Sudbury Mutual Aid Fire Fighters Association and also Deputy Fire Chief. For 12 years Tullio served our Community as Fire Chief and Coordinator of the First Response Team.



Tullio was involved in re-writing the Ontario Fire Code and the Ontario Building Code which is still in effect today. Tullio has been retired for the past 20 years from the railway but still is very much involved in community development. Tullio served as volunteer in many organizations such as the Lion's Club, Knights of Columbus, Red Cross, Heart and Stroke Foundation, Canadian Cancer Foundation and many others.
