

By-law 2015-201

A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Authorize a Waiver of Certain Fees under By-law 2006-280 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury Dealing with the Collection, Removal, and Disposal of Waste within the City of Greater Sudbury


Whereas By-law 2006-280, being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury Dealing with the Collection, Removal and Disposal of Waste within the City of Greater Sudbury contains a prohibition against a person depositing or delivering waste to any waste disposal site operated by the City without paying the appropriate fee for that type of waste, unless the waste fits within the exceptions provided for in the By-law;

And Whereas Council for the City of Greater Sudbury has determined that it is in order to waive tipping fees otherwise payable for depositing at a waste disposal site operated by the City, all waste resulting from or associated with the demolition authorized at property municipally known as 4420 Long Lake Road, Sudbury being PIN 73476-0482(LT), and the remediation of the said property;


Now therefore the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

1. Despite subsection 23(1) of By-law 2006-280, being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury Dealing with the Collection, Removal and Disposal of Waste within the City of Greater Sudbury as amended, all waste resulting from or associated with the demolition work at property municipally known as 4420 Long Lake Road, Sudbury being PIN 73476-0482(LT) and from the work related to the remediation of the said property, may be deposited at a waste disposal site operated by the City of Greater Sudbury without the payment of fees otherwise applicable under By-law 2006-280, upon the General Manager of Infrastructure Services being satisfied as to the source of the waste.
2. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon passage.
