# **Background**

The purpose of this report is to bring forward the names of the applicants to fill the positions on the newly created Sustainable Mobility Advisory Panel.

## **Membership**

Membership for this panel is a combination of citizens and stakeholders.

Members of Council are not required to sit on Advisory Panels although they may choose to be members or informally attend meetings of those panels which are of interest. Pursuant to the Municipal Act and the City's Procedure By-law, members of Council may not form the majority of members of an Advisory Panel.

Councillor McIntosh has advised the City Clerk's Office of her interest to sit on the Advisory Panel. Members of Council may add or remove their name to an Advisory Panel at the meeting.

Representatives from the Rainbow Routes Association; Coalition for a Liveable Sudbury; Sudbury Cycles; Friends of Sudbury Transit; Sudbury & District Health Unit; Greater Sudbury Police Services; and a CGS staff member from Roads & Transportation Services, Transit Services and Leisure Services, have been recommended to the Nominating Committee by those bodies and are included in the resolution.

The Nominating Committee is being asked to select one (1) citizen at large representing cyclists, one (1) citizen at large representing pedestrians, one (1) citizen at large representing transit users, and one (1) citizen at large representing persons with disabilities.

## **Term**

The term of this advisory panel will begin upon appointment of members and end on November 30, 2018.

## Selection

A deadline of Friday, June 12, 2015 at 4:30 p.m. was set to receive applications to fill positions on the Sustainable Mobility Advisory Panel. Advertisements were placed in local newspapers as well as in other media outlets. Applications and information regarding the panel were posted online and available in the Clerk's Office as well as the Citizen Services Centres.

The selection of these positions is to be conducted in accordance with Article 44 of the City of Greater Sudbury's Procedure By-law.

Council's procedure requires that in the event more candidates are nominated for the required position(s), then those position(s) will be chosen by a simultaneous vote.

Once the candidates have been selected for the positions, a resolution will be introduced confirming the appointment of the successful candidates.
