DRAFT TRANSPORTATION STUDY

Complete Streets



- excellent that we are moving in this direction



- policy needs refinement
- no proposed development of Complete Streets Guidelines
- current Levels of Service for roads only look at motor vehicular traffic, not all modes of transportation

DRAFT TRANSPORTATION STUDY

Road Classifications and Design Standards



- excellent that all modes of transportation are now included




- only implemented on new roads – no recommendation or plan to retrofit existing and dangerous roads
- refinement needed for cycling facility types options

DRAFT TRANSPORTATION STUDY

Active Transportation Master Plan

 • excellent that a plan is finally being proposed

 • plan needs to be changed significantly and should contain additional details including annual project priorities, timelines and budget

- plan needs altered priorities, facility type choices, and network phasing

DRAFT TRANSPORTATION STUDY

Active Transportation Master Plan



- current proposed AT network infrastructure does not meet the needs all people who bike
- additional community consultation required

DRAFT TRANSPORTATION STUDY

Transportation Demand Management (TDM)



- mentioned in the document



- TDM Plan and Strategy needed to ensure TDM is implemented and integral to the Transportation Master Plan
- Implications for the Sustainability Focused Option

DRAFT TRANSPORTATION STUDY

Changes to Official Plan



- Proposed wording needs major revisions
- No adoption of Section 10: Transportation until Transportation Study is finalized
