### Background

This report sets out the procedure for the election by the Committee of the Chair and Vice-Chair of the Community Services Committee for the term ending December 31, 2015.

The Procedure By-law provides that a Member of the Committee shall be appointed annually by the Committee to serve as Chair of the Community Services Committee. As well, a Vice-Chair is appointed annually.

The above appointments need only be confirmed by resolution.

### Remuneration

The Chair of the Community Services Committee is paid \$2,004.98 per annum.

### Selection

The selection of the Chair and Vice-Chair is to be conducted in accordance with Article 45 of the Procedure By-law.
