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## Recommendations Status

1. 20% have been completed.
2. 66% will be completed by Q2 of 2014
3. 95% will be completed by Q4 of 2014



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## **Recommendations # 3, 20, 22 and 24**

- **Further corporate analysis required**
  - **#3, Fire related by-laws**
  - **#20, Required equipment**
  - **#22, Work plan with Building Services**
  - **#24, Records management system**



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**Recommendation # 1, Risk Assessment, complete.**

**With the completion of the Risk Assessment, we now have a sampling of occupancies that is based on risk (extreme, high, moderate and low).**

**With this information, Recommendation # 6, to create a routine inspection program, is now close to completion.**



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## **Ontario Regulation 150/13 :**

### **An amendment to the Ontario Fire Code**

- A new challenge for the Fire Prevention Section**
- Affects all care occupancies, care and treatment occupancies as well as retirement homes**
- Fire Services must validate an annual approved fire drill at each occupancy ensuring the proper implementation of the approved Fire Safety Plan, and that adequate staffing and training is scheduled, as well as Fire Code compliance.**



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## **Recommendation # 8, Review of Property Files**

**Purpose:** To ascertain all outstanding fire code violations or fire hazards, including the provision of a Fire Safety Plan, have been addressed.

**Challenges:** Conducting day to day tasks will be affected as staff will be reassigned to conduct these “open files”.
