By-law 2019-187

A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Authorize Entering into an Agreement with Public Health Agency of Canada to Accept Transfer of Equipment from Public Health Agency of Canada

Whereas the Public Health Agency of Canada is divesting itself of certain emergency preparedness equipment forming part of the National Emergency Strategic Stockpile being stored in the City of Greater Sudbury and has offered to transfer same to the City of Greater Sudbury;

And Whereas the City of Greater Sudbury would benefit from supplementing the equipment available to it for use in emergency situations;

And Whereas the municipality has the authority to accept such a donation;

Now therefore Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

1. Council of the City of Greater Sudbury authorizes the Interim General Manager of Community Safety to enter into an agreement with the Public Health Agency of Canada to accept the transfer of certain supplies and equipment from the National Emergency Strategic Stockpile, and to execute all required documents complete the relocation of the items so transferred.

2. The associated registration costs to relocate and store the items to be transferred will be funded from the operating budget of the Community Safety Department.

3. This By-law comes into effect upon passage.
