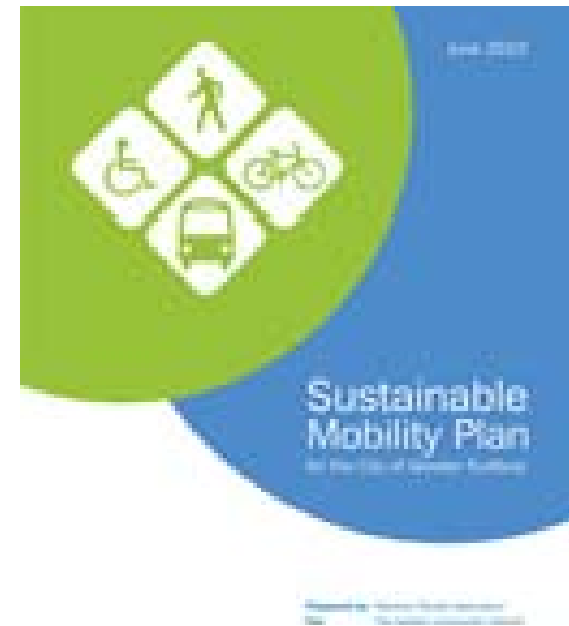

Current Stroller Policy

- Strollers and walkers **MUST** be folded and stored on end in a safe place as to not interfere with other passengers.
- Babies must be taken out of strollers and be held in your arms.

New Transit Stroller Policy



- Strollers can use the priority seating area given priority to (1) People in wheelchairs or scooters (2) persons with disabilities
- Strollers restricted to single strollers and double length strollers
