BY-LAW 2012 –

A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY TO PROVIDE FOR THE HORIZON 2011 MUNICIPAL DRAINAGE WORKS IN THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury in accordance with the provisions of the Drainage Act, R.S.O. 1990, appointed K. Smart Associates Limited to complete a Section 78 Amendment to the 2005 Horizon Municipal Drain Engineer’s Report;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury has procured a report made by K. Smart Associates Limited and the said report is attached hereto and forms part of this By-Law as Schedule “A”;

AND WHEREAS the estimated total cost of construction of the drainage works is \$1,060,540;

AND WHEREAS the Council is of the opinion that the proposed drainage works is desirable;

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY HEREBY ENACTS AS
FOLLOWS:**

1. The report by K. Smart Associates Limited dated February 8, 2012 attached hereto as Schedule “A” is hereby adopted and the drainage works as therein indicated and set forth is hereby authorized, and shall be completed in accordance herewith.
2. The City of Greater Sudbury may borrow on the credit of the City in the amount of \$1,060,540 being the necessary amount for construction of the drainage works.
3. All assessments greater than \$50 are subject to the City of Greater Sudbury Front End Financing Program as approved by Council Resolution # FA2012-22 which is set forth in Schedule “B”, and forms part of this By-Law;
4. The schedule of Assessments from the report dated February 8, 2012 is set forth in Schedule “C”, and forms part of this By-Law.
5. This By-Law comes into force and effect upon the passing thereof and may be cited as the “Horizon 2011 Drain By-Law”.
