Report Summary

Bid Solicitations are advertised electronically on the City's website in the form of either Request for Tender or Request for Proposal. Where a Request for Tender is used, the Award is to the lowest Compliant Bid. Where a Request for Proposal is used, the Award is to the highest scored Compliant Bid based on Best Value. Best Value is defined as the optimal balance of performance and cost determined in accordance with pre-defined evaluation criteria; all in accordance with the Purchasing By-Law.

During the reporting period there were thirty-two (32) Contract Awards and two (2) non-competitive Contract Awards exceeding \$100,000. There is also one (1) Contract Award from the previous reporting period.

Financial Implications

Sufficient funding exists within the previous approved budgets in accordance with the Operating and Capital Budget Policies at that time. Council approved policies for the Operating and Capital Budgets enable staff to reallocate operating budget dollars or obtain funding from the respective Holding Account Reserve (for

Capital only) in order to award tenders when the tendered amount exceeds the budgeted amount. The budget amount is an estimate whereas the tendered amount is the actual cost received by the City through a competitive tender process from the marketplace.

BACKGROUND

This report provides a summary of procurements \$100,000 or greater for the period of April 1, 2019 to June 30, 2019.

As required by the City of Greater Sudbury's Purchasing By-Law:

- Section 8(2), regular information reports shall be provided to Council on the Bid Solicitations, cooperative purchases, Emergency purchases and Revenue Generating Contracts Awarded with a Total Acquisition Cost or revenue of \$100,000 or greater.
- Section 26(2), soon after the purchase as reasonably possible, a report to Council is required advising of the circumstances of the Emergency Purchase when greater than \$100,000. Only emergency procurements where budget authorization is not required are included in this report. All other emergencies will be reported separately.
