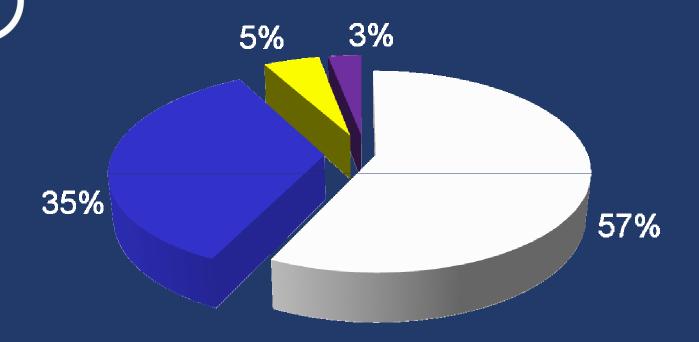

2012 Base Budget: Sources of Revenue \$58.4 Million

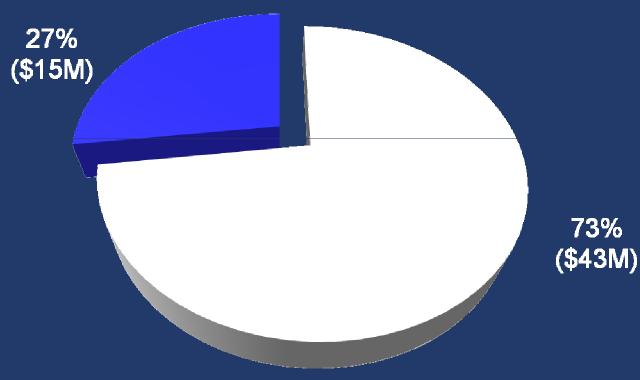


■ Variable ■ Fixed ■ Tax Levy ■ Other



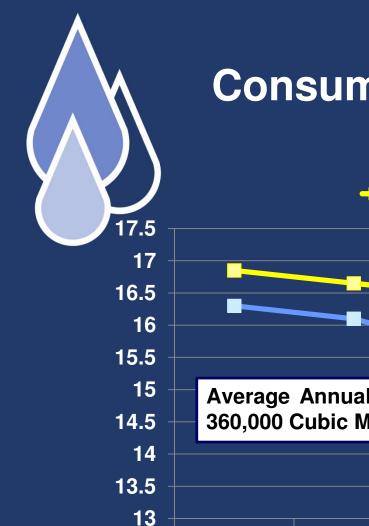
Fixed versus Variable Costs





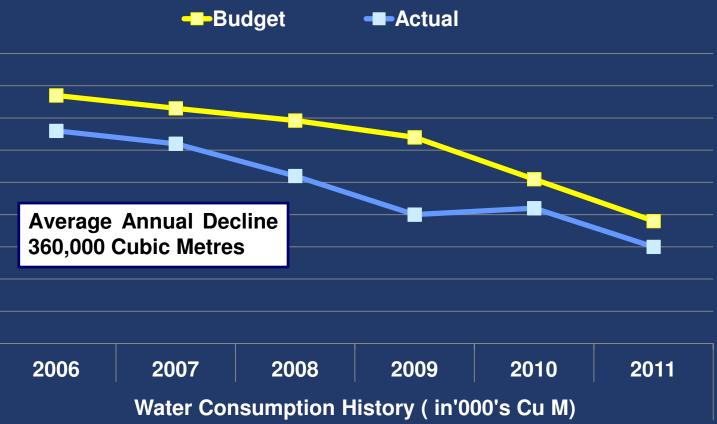
■ Fixed Costs

2012 Base Budget Rates

(Residence using 250 cubic metres)

Water Rate (variable per cubic metre) \$1.124

Water Rate (fixed per month) \$16.34

Wastewater Surcharge 112.3%





2012 Base Budget Increases:

(Residence using 250 cubic metres)

Water Rate – Variable 4.0%

Water Rate – Fixed 4.0%

Wastewater Surcharge 4.4%

Overall Increase of 4.2%

Overall Annual Increase of \$41

Breakdown of overall residential increase of 4.2% or \$41 per annum

Conclusions from 2010 Rate Study Review



- Continue to generate approximately 35% of user fees from fixed charges to ensure revenue stability
- Continue to charge a uniform variable consumption rate for water consumed
- Continue to levy a wastewater surcharge on the fixed and variable water rates



2012 Fixed Water Service Charges



Meter Size (inches)	Monthly Fixed Charge
5/8	\$16.34
1	\$24.18
2	\$65.82



Existing Policy for Fixed Meter Rates



- ➤ Water variable rate increase applied to 5/8 inch meter fixed rate
- Equivalency ratios for monthly fixed service charges

5/8 inch meter = \$16.34 per month

X Ratio of 1.48 1 inch meter = \$24.18 per month

Fixed Charge as a % of Total WWW Bill



Meter Size (inches)	Cubic Metres	CGS	BMA Survey
5/8	250	41%	25%
1	1,000	21%	27%
2	10,000	7%	10%



Options Prepared:



Option 1: Staff Recommendation

- Freeze the 2012 monthly service charge for customers using a 5/8 inch meter (mainly residential) to better align with other municipal peers
- Foregone fixed charge revenue passed along to high volume customers

Option 2: Status Quo



Impact of Recommendation



➤ 2012 Proposed Ratio less than AWWA (2.5) and BMA Survey (2.38)

5/8 inch meter = \$15.71 per month

X Ratio of 2.11 1 inch meter = \$33.09 per month



44,000 customers	Residential (5/8 inch service)
Overall Rate Increase	4.2%
Impact of Freezing Residential Fixed Service Charge at 2011 Rate (\$16.34 to \$15.71)	(1.7%)
Overall WWW Rate Increase	2.5%

Impact on Typical Residence WWW Bill 2012 Increase from 2011 (estimated 250 cubic metres)

	2011	2012	Annual Increase \$	Annual Increase %
Water Consumption Charges	\$270.25	\$281.00	\$10.75	4.0%
Monthly Water Fixed Charges	\$188.52	\$188.52	-	0%
Wastewater Charges	\$513.36	\$527.27	\$13.91	2.0%
Total Water and Wastewater Costs	\$972.13	\$996.79	\$24.66	2.5%



Overall Rate Impact: High Volume Customers

Water Consumption Charges	\$1,081	\$1,124	\$43	4.0%
Monthly Water Fixed Charges	\$280	\$397	\$117	42%
Wastewater Charges	\$1,522	\$1,708	\$186	12%
Total Water and Wastewater Costs	\$2,883	\$3,229	\$346	12.0%

2012 BUDGET ENHANCEMENTS AND IMPACT ON RATES



Water / Wastewater Budget Enhancements



Five operating budget enhancement options	\$188K	0.3%
Increase inflation on capital envelopes	\$537K	1.0%
Sustainable Capital increase	\$282K	0.6%
Sustainable Capital increase	\$637K	1.3%
Total	\$1.6M	3.2%





Options for Residential Increases

5/8 inch service (250 cubic metres)

Options	1	2	3	4
2012 Increase	4.2%	4.2%	4.2%	4.2%
Add: 5 Operating Enhancements	-	0.3%	0.3%	0.3%
Add: Inflation on Capital	-	1.0%	1.0%	1.0%
Add: SCAMP	-	-	0.6%	1.9%
Overall Increase	4.2%	5.5%	6.1%	7.4%





Options for Residential Increases

5/8 inch service (250 cubic metres)

Options	1	2	3	4
Range of Increases	4.2%	5.5%	6.1%	7.4%
Less: Freeze of Fixed Monthly Rate	(1.7%)	(2.2%)	(2.3%)	(2.1%)
2012 Proposed Increases	2.5%	3.3%	3.8%	5.3%





Options for Residential Increases

5/8 inch service (250 cubic metres)

Options	1	2	3	4
2012 Proposed Increases	2.5%	3.3%	3.8%	5.3%
Increase(\$)	\$25	\$32	\$37	\$52
