Administrative Services - Reconciliation

- 2012 Operating Base Budget
 - Increased below the rate of inflation
 - 0.6% increase (\$17,207) over 2011 budget
- Re-allocation of Capital Envelopes
 - 2011 one time reduction of 33% or \$100,000
 - Restored in 2012
- Operating + Capital Envelope Contribution

Budget

- 4.3 % or \$117,207

Administrative Services - Budget Highlights

- IT offsets \$142,000 increase in licence costs
- Legal Services saves \$19,000 by assuming Tax Sales work
- Reduces advertising costs by \$75,000
- Reduces annual contribution to Election Reserve by 14.9% or \$40,000
- Clerk's Services re-organization saves \$35,000 in salaries and benefits

Administrative Services- Accomplishments

- Process reviews
 - OMBI + POA process better controls and more capacity
 - Used mail vehicle AVL data to reduce 1 vehicle and save \$10,000
- Aggressive review of office expenses
 - Legal reduced from \$54,000 in 2009 to \$20,000 in 2011
- New Ways of Working
 - Social media as a cost effective tool to encourage civic engagement while reducing cost of traditional print ads
 - Facebook impressions = 4.3 million for the mybus promotion and 1.5 million for Market Square Public Input
 - CGS Facebook posts garner 52,000 views per month
 - Elimination of 40 fax lines saves \$25,000
 - Award winning Enterprise GIS


OMBI Performance Measures
