

Sources of Project Capital

- Capital Cost: \$7.0M Total Required
 - \$5M required for Phase I build
- Capital Funding in hand: \$2.5M
 - \$1M from Xstrata Nickel,
 - NOHFC: \$1M,
 - \$500k from City
- Grants in play:
 - NOHFC: \$1M,
 - FedNor: \$1M

 - > Tender and Award Construction Contract
 - > Construction Start Date
- > Step 3: Complete Phase I Build Fall 2012*
 - ➤ Move Into Facility
 - Continue Fundraising for Phase II
