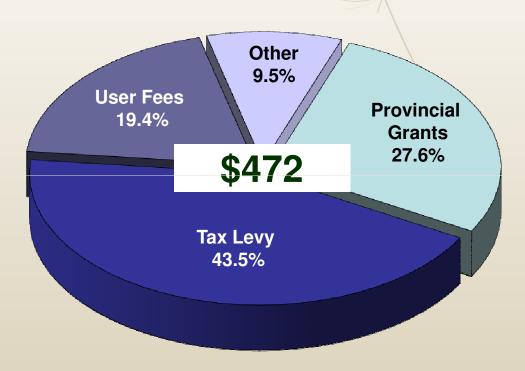

Sources of Revenues 2011 Budget

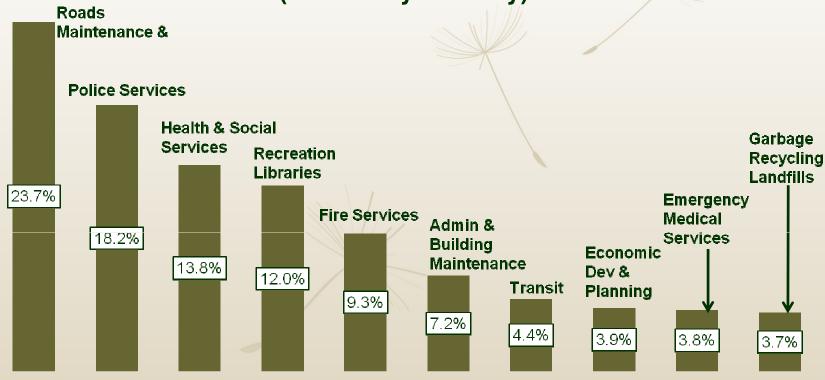






2011 Budget Net Expenditures

Toward Fiscal Sustainability and Long Term Financial Plan

- Revenues sufficient to meet current and future expenses
- > Build and replace capital assets
- Municipal services
- Stability in property taxes and intergenerational equity
- > Sound financial management and health





Challenges for 2012

- > Need for additional capital funding
- Desire to maintain low property taxes
- Program expansion, growth related expenditures, Council priorities
- > Costs of compliance with regulations
- > Inflation and contractual obligations
