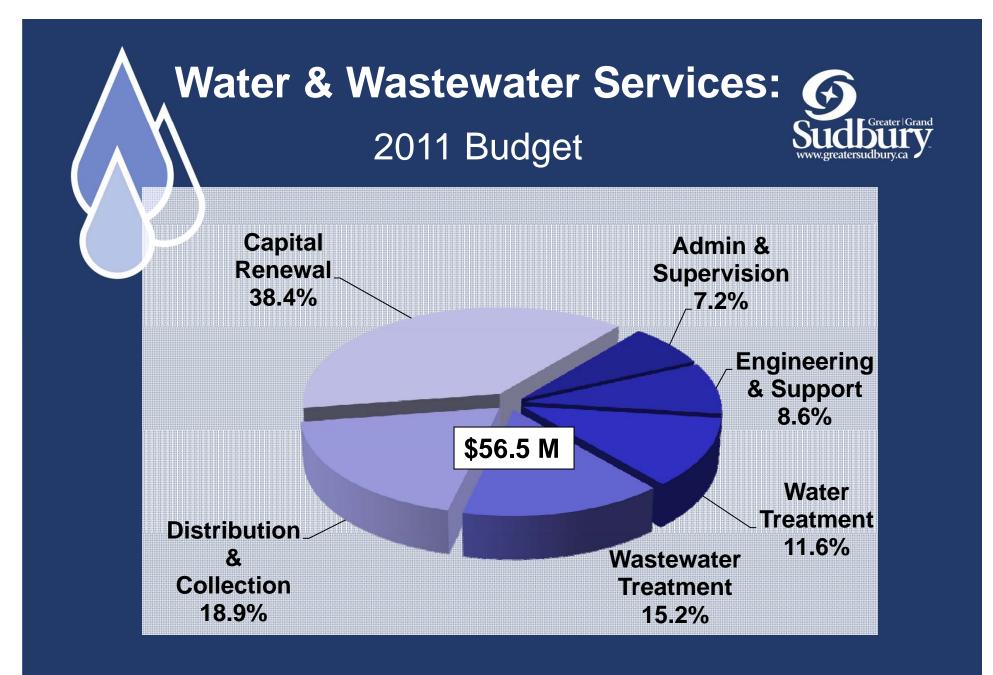

# Water / Wastewater Budget Proposed Increases:



Water Rate	5.2%
Fixed Water Rate	5.2%
Wastewater Surcharge	1.8%
Fixed Wastewater Rate	1.8%

#### **Overall Increase of 3.4%**

### Water and Wastewater Breakdown of Overall Increase of 3.4% or \$40 per Annum

SCAMP \$1.2 M 2.4% Contractual increases 2.7% \$1.4 M Reduction in internally (3.7%) <u>(\$1.9M)</u> allocated charges \$0.7 M **Base Rate Increase** 1.4% Consumption decrease 2.0% **Overall WWW Increase** <u>3.4%</u>

Capital Enhancement Option

2012 Capital Requirement per Financial Plan	\$27.0 M
2011 Capital Funding	\$23.5 M
Differential (Sustainability Gap)	\$3.5 M

Additional Rate Increase	1.7%	3.5%

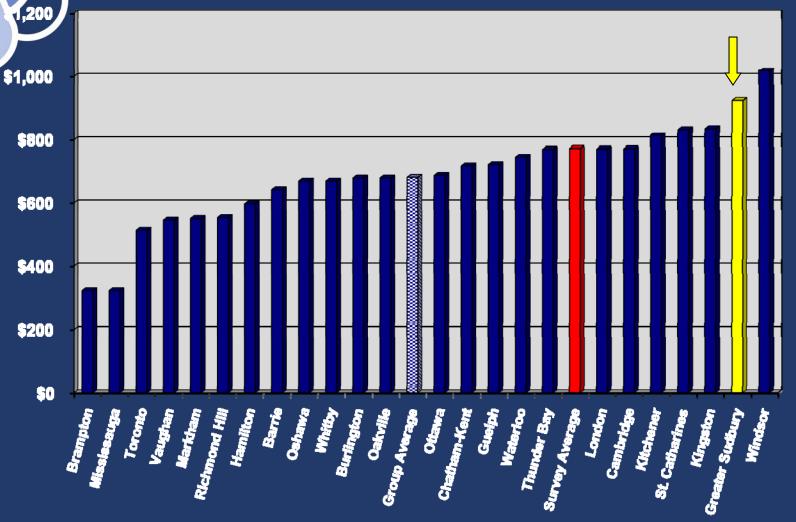


# 2010 BMA MUNICIPAL STUDY



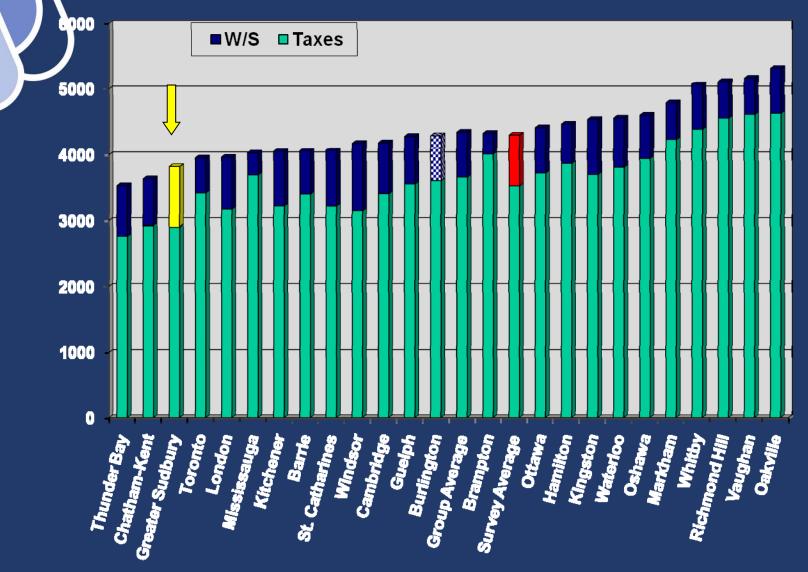
### 2010 Residential Water/Wastewater





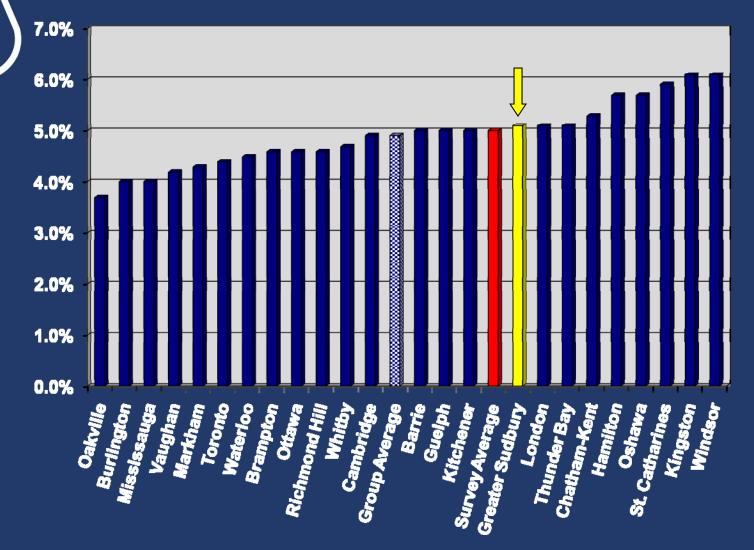
# Bungalow Taxes & Water / Sewer Rates





## 2010 Property Taxes + W/S as a % of Income





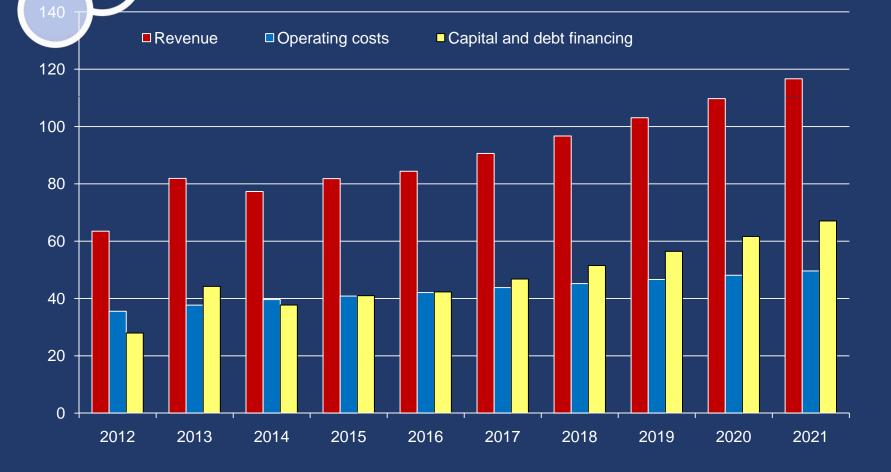

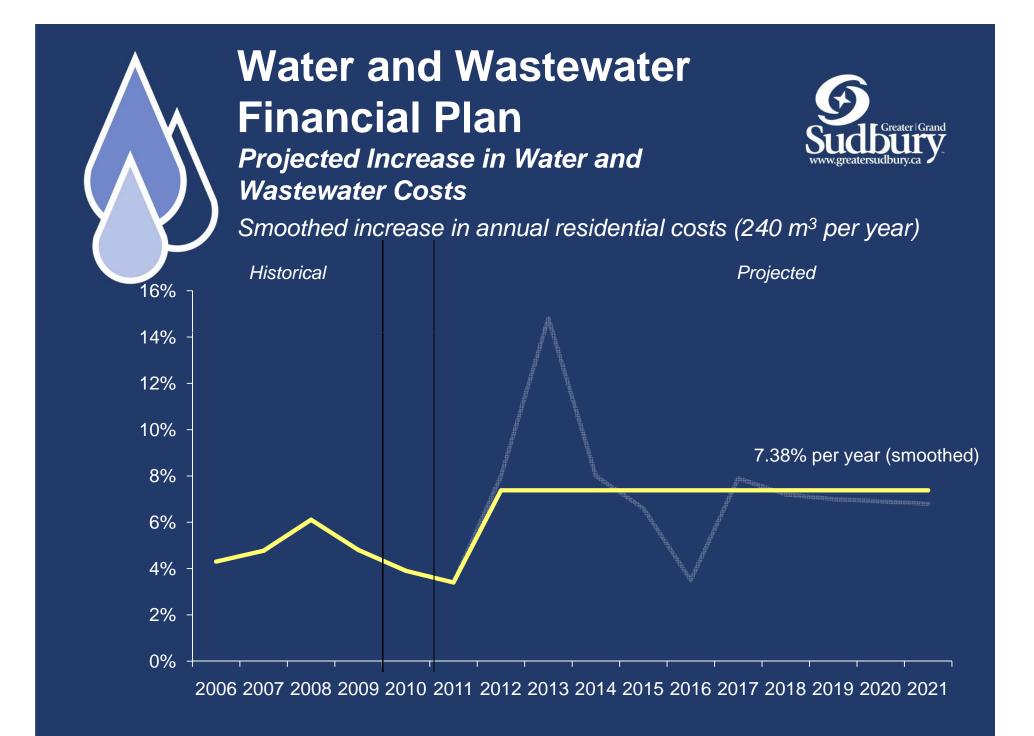
