Background



Financial Planning for Water and Wastewater Services Regulatory Framework

- Licensing of water systems in Ontario is a requirement under the Safe Water Drinking Act, 2002
- A condition of licensing is the preparation of a financial plan
 - Form and content of the plan is prescribed under Ontario Regulation 453/07
 - Required to be approved by Council
- Public communication is a required element



Financial Planning for Water and Wastewater Services What is a Financial Plan?

- Estimate of future financial outcomes based on actual experience and estimated future economic conditions
- Comprehensive financial strategy to achieve future goals
- Benchmark to measure progress
- Dynamic




Financial Planning for Water and Wastewater Services What is Financial Sustainability?

- Revenues that are sufficient to provide for:
 - Operating costs
 - Debt servicing costs
 - Capital rehabilitation and replacement
- Meet or exceed regulatory and environmental protection standards
- Capital expenditures equal to 2% of replacement value



Water and Wastewater Services *Infrastructure*



- 12 treatment facilities
- 1,700 km of mains
- Replacement value of \$2.3 billion





Key Assumptions Consumption


Historical and forecasted consumption (in millions of m³)





Key Assumptions Operating Costs


Projected operating costs (in millions of dollars)


Projected financial performance (in millions of dollars)



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Water and Wastewater Financial Plan Projected Increase in Water and Wastewater Costs


Percentage increase in annual residential costs (240 m³ per year)






Water and Wastewater Financial Plan Projected Increase in Water and Wastewater Costs

Water and Wastewater Financial Plan Council Resolution

- **THAT** the report of the CFO/Treasurer and General Manager of Infrastructure dated March 2, 2011 entitled Financial Plan for Water and Waste Water Services as required under Ontario Regulation 453/07 be received;
- AND THAT the Finance Committee recommends that Council endorses the Financial Plan for Water and Wastewater Services as financially viable;
- AND THAT the Finance Committee recommends that Council, as the owner of the City of Greater Sudbury municipal drinking water and wastewater systems, approve the Financial Plan for Water and Wastewater Services in compliance with Ontario Regulation 453/07;
- AND THAT staff submit the Financial Plan for Water and Wastewater Services to the Province in compliance with Ontario Regulation 453/07;
- AND THAT the Financial Plan for Water and Wastewater Services be updated on a regular basis and included in the Water and Waste budgets presented to Council.
