# The Current State of Affairs



#### Examples From Across Ontario

- Kingston (pop 152 000)
  - \$3000 annual start-up and enhancement fund,
  - Community Gardens Coordinator (staff liaison),
  - creation of the Community Garden Network
- Kitchener (pop 204 000)
  - \$2000 grant for new community garden projects (no limit per year)
- Ottawa
  - \$75,000 available annually for start-ups and enhancement (equivalent to \$15 000/160 000 citizens)



#### **Budget Request**

- \$10 000 annual fund for 4 years
  - capital funds for new and existing community gardens
  - support for Community Garden Network
- Become a partner in sustainable urban agriculture
- Become a "Grown in Northern Ontario" example of how to cultivate community
