## BY-LAW 2010 -

## BEING A BY-LAW OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY TO PROVIDE FOR THE JOANETTE MUNICIPAL DRAINAGE WORKS IN THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY

WHEREAS the requisite number of owners have petitioned the Council of the City of Greater Sudbury in accordance with the provisions of the Drainage Act, R.S.O., 1990, Chapter D. 17, requesting that the following lands and roads be drained by a drainage works on Parts of Lots 4 and 5, Concession 1 and Lots 4 to 6, Concession 2, in the geographic Township of Balfour in the City of Greater Sudbury;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Greater has procured a report made by K. Smart Associates Ltd. and the said report is attached hereto and forms part of the By-law as Appendix A;

AND WHEREAS the estimated total cost of constructing the drainage works is \$ 186,200;

AND WHEREAS the Council is of the opinion that the drainage of the area is desirable;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY HEREBY

ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- The report dated August 30, 2010 by K. Smart Associates Ltd. attached hereto as Schedule "A" is hereby adopted and the drainage works as therein indicated and set forth is hereby authorized, and shall be completed in accordance herewith.
- The City of Greater Sudbury may borrow on the credit of the City in the amount of \$ 186,200 being the necessary amount for construction to the drainage works.

4.	The schedule of Assessments from the report dated August 30, 3010 is set forth in
	Schedule A, and forms part of this By-law.
5.	This By-law comes into force and effect upon the passing thereof and may be cited as
	"JOANETTE" By-law".
