It's not easy and it's not safe."



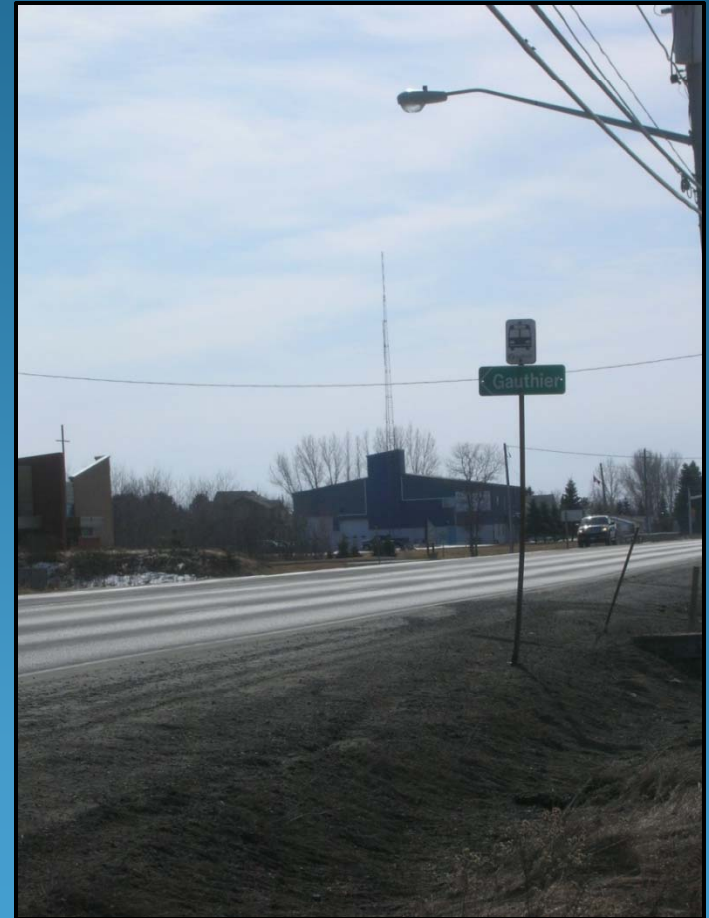

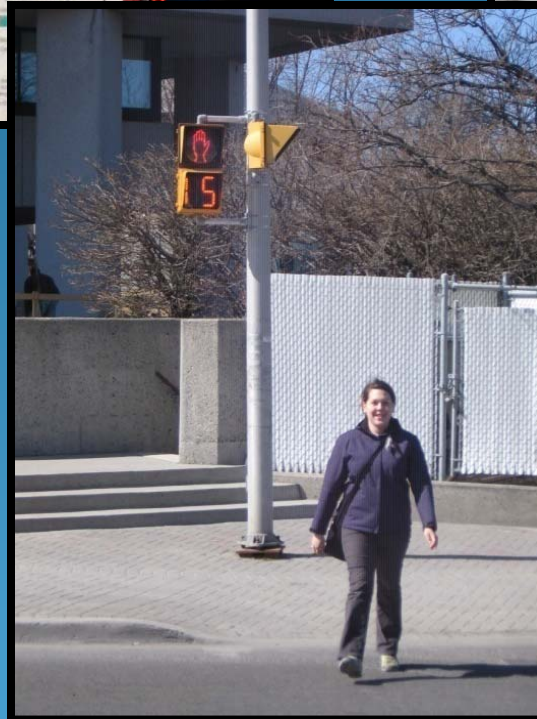
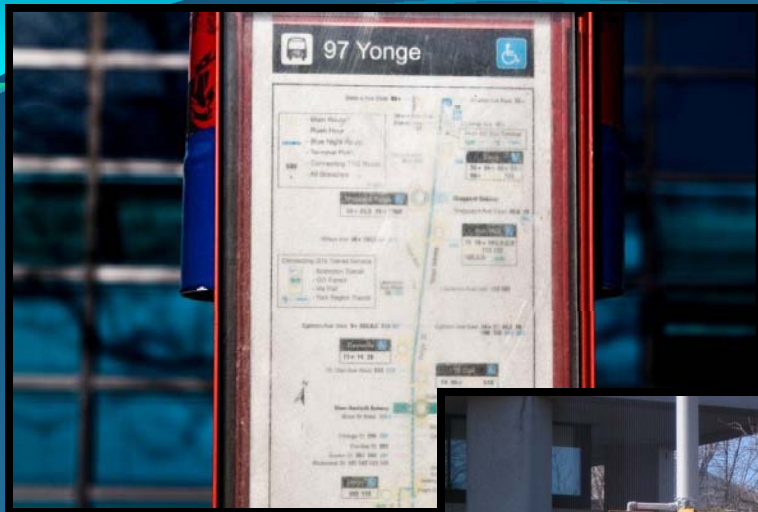
