



 Saving and enhancing more lives through organ and tissue donation in Ontario






# Organ and Tissue Donation The Facts

- Everyone is a potential donor
- One organ donor can save the lives of up to 8 people
  - Heart, liver, kidneys, pancreas, lungs, small bowel, stomach
- One tissue donor can enhance the lives of up to 75 people
  - eyes, heart valves, bone and skin
- Every three days someone in Ontario dies while waiting for a life-saving transplant.
  - The number of new patients added to the transplant waiting list grows each year Canadian Organ Replacement Register, Canadian Institute for Health Information 2005


