- Existing Sewer Use By-law (1973)
- Contaminants
- Fats, Oils & Grease (FOG)
- High Extraneous Flow Rates









#### Contaminants:

- Toxic Chemicals
- Heavy Metals
- Personal Care Products & Pharmaceuticals (PPCP's)








## Consequences of Fats, Oils & Grease (FOG)



Clean Sewer

- Reduced Sanitary System Capacity
- Higher Risk of Back-ups & Spills
- Increased Operating & Maintenance Costs
- Reduced Lifecycle of Sanitary Sewer System



FOG Impacted Sewer







## Consequences of Excessive I/I




- Overloaded Sanitary Systems
- Higher Risk of Flooding, Spills & Treatment Bypasses
- Increased Operational & Maintenance Costs

- Enhanced Environmental Protection
- Reduced Risk of Backups, Environmental Spills & Treatment Bypasses
- Better Protection of Employees, Infrastructure & Capacity
- Reduced Capital and O&M costs;
- Improved Customer Service





### Source Control Program Elements



- Education & Outreach
- User Inventory & Discharge Authorization
- Best Management Practices
  - Disconnection Programs
  - Compliance Agreements
  - Pollution Prevention Plans
  - Trucked Liquid Waste Management
- Inspection, Monitoring & Enforcement
