

**By-law 2019-114**

**A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Close  
Two Unopened Lane Allowances in Sudbury  
Described as PINs 02131-0078(LT) and 02131-0079(LT)**


**Whereas** in accordance with the provisions of Section 34 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, the Council of every municipality may pass by-laws for permanently closing a highway or part of a highway;

**And Whereas** Council of the City of Greater Sudbury deems it desirable that a by-law be passed closing two unopened lane allowances legally described as PINs 02131-0078(LT) and 02131-0079(LT) on Plan 18SB, Township of McKim and being located west and east of the unopened portion of Kehoe Avenue in Sudbury;

**Now therefore Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:**

1. That two unopened lane allowances legally described as PINs 02131-0078(LT) and 02131-0079(LT) on Plan 18SB, Township of McKim and being located west and east of the unopened portion of Kehoe Avenue in Sudbury are hereby permanently closed.
2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect when registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Registry Division of Sudbury (No. 53) pursuant to Section 34 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*.
