Background:

This addendum report is provided to highlight that while the development charges have been frozen by Council, the composition of revenues per services category has changed in accordance with the Background Study.

See attached summary of the composition of the current and proposed development charges.

Based on the recommendation of the Chief Building Official, staff are recommending the inclusion of a transitional provision in the by-law, to allow for complete building permit applications received prior to July 9th, to pay rates under By-law 2004-200F. This addition to the by-law will only impact development that will occur in areas not serviced by municipal water and sewer.

New Development Charges Rates

According to the Development Charges Act, "A development charge is payable for a development upon a building permit being issued for the development unless the Development Charge By-law provides otherwise under subsection (2).1997, c. 27, s. 26 (1)".

Although Council has approved to freeze development charges at \$3,079 per residential unit and \$1,859 per multi-residential unit, the composition of the amount collected under each service category has changed based on the growth related capital projects outlined in the Background Study.

The following development charges are in effect as of July 9, 2009 to December 31, 2009 under By-law 2009-200F.

You will note a significant increase if the development is not serviced by municipal water and sewer.

As previously presented to Council, staff are recommending the inclusion of the following paragraph in the By-law:

Complete building permit applications received and deemed to be complete by the Chief Building Official on or before July 8th, 2009, and processed within 90 days of the passage of the by-law, would pay development charges in accordance with the existing 2004 bylaw.

Building permit applications received on or after July 9th, 2009 would pay the new rates.

Summary

It is recommended that the By-law be amended to include the above noted transitional provision.
