Becoming Contractor Dependent

- In the past contractors were used to supplement the city's workforce (ie: in case of emergencies).
- Contractors have been hired to provide full time municipal services



Providing Municipal Services

- Who should be providing services to our citizens?
- The answer is easy...
 WE SHOULD
- We can't leave ourselves with our backs against a wall with no option but to continue paying others to do our work.
- Council and staff say that our employees are our most valuable assets.

Our Proposal

- 17 additional staff
- Use existing equipment and replace as necessary using internal cost recovery process established to ensure that money is available to repair and replace equipment.
- No shortage of work that our employees can be completing instead of paying contractors



Our Employees Can Do:

- Potholes (\$380,000)
- Snow Dump (\$232,000)
- Fire Hydrant Snow Clearing (Costs unknown)
- Catch Basin Clearing (Costs unknown)
- Storm Sewer Repair and Clearing (Costs unknown)
- Winging back roads to widen them (\$150,000)
- Clearing Bus Stops and necessary snow removal (\$113,000)
- Clearing Intersections MT's currently plow through (Costs unknown)
- Snow Removal at all Community Centres and Arenas
- Plow 74 Lift Stations (Costs unknown)
- Winter Ditching, Spring Cleaning (\$476,000 budgeted to contractors)
- Push snow dumps in outlying areas (Costs unknown)
