Report Title

Winter Sidewalk Maintenance Standard and Service Level

Budget Impact / Policy Implication



This report has been reviewed by the Finance Division and the funding source has been identified.

If approved, Budget Options will be prepared for the 2009 Budget in the amount of \$250,000 permanent funding and \$500,000 one-time Capital Equipment funding.

Recommendation

That Council approve Proposed Option #2 of the Winter Sidewalk Maintenance Standard and Service Level report from the General Manager of Infrastructure Services dated October 20, 2008 and that Staff be directed to bring forward to the 2009 Budget a permanent Operations Budget Option in the amount of \$250,000 and a one-time Capital Equipment Budget Option of \$500,000.

1.0 Introduction:

At the Priorities Meeting on May 7, 2008 Staff presented the background on the winter maintenance history for sidewalks in the new City. In brief, the standards followed by each individual municipality pre-amalgamation have been continued. A copy of the presentation is attached as **Appendix 'A'**. At that meeting, Staff requested general direction from Council to permit Staff to prepare detailed cost estimates for various service levels.

Council was presented with three (3) options as follows:

- Option #1: Adopt the Sidewalk Policy recommended in the Official Plan
- Option #2: Maintain Substandard Sidewalks (sidewalks less than 1.5 metres (5 feet) in width)
- Option #3: Require Property Owners to provide winter maintenance on sidewalks abutting their property

Council eliminated Option #3 and requested that Staff analyze Options #1 and #2.

Also, Council requested:

1. the cost of changing the service times from the current four (4) to twenty-four (24) hour period (timing dependent upon the severity of the storm), to either a four (4) to twelve (12) hour or four (4) to eight (8) hour period;
2. the cost to provide timely snow removal at all bus stops. This option would be carried out by either City crews if available or Contractors;
3. service levels on pathways and in parks adjoining cul-de-sacs etc.; and
4. that issues of the Seniors Advisory Panel be considered.

2.0 Background:

The Official Plan states that an integrated sidewalk system is essential for the physical well-being of our residents and community. The Official Plan recommends that an integrated sidewalk system be provided in the community. Sidewalks should be provided on both sides of Arterial and Collector Roadways in urban areas, and along one (1) side of all Residential Roadways in urban areas.

The sidewalk system will provide safe pedestrian access to community destinations including schools, community centres, playgrounds, senior centres, religious institutions, etc.

Similarly, asphalt paved sidewalks / footpaths and/or walkways that run parallel to roads and / or connect / link streets / subdivisions etc. and form an integral part of the pedestrian system should be part of the sidewalk system.

Our current Policy is to have sidewalks in new subdivisions built to meet these conditions and criteria. Similarly when the City reconstructs streets, where possible, sidewalks will be added to streets as required. Similarly reconstructed streets with sidewalks currently on both sides that require sidewalks only on one (1) side will be rebuilt with sidewalks on one (1) side.

As budgets permit, the City constructs the 'connecting' links between new subdivisions and existing sidewalk systems to develop and expand our integrated sidewalk system i.e. Penman Avenue in Garson constructed in 2007.

Staff have consolidated the original options presented on May 7, 2008 into a single Proposed Option as the only difference is in the width of the sidewalks.

Proposed Option #1 recommends that the standards recommended in the Official Plan be followed. Staff fully support this recommendation however, some additional background information is provided.

Winter maintenance continues to be provided on sidewalks on some Residential streets within the former City of Sudbury which do not meet the recommended criteria. In 1984, the former City reviewed their sidewalk winter maintenance standard in an attempt to provide a consistent-satisfactory service level but also with the desire to reduce costs. The former City attempted to implement the proposed maintenance standard recommended herein. However, as many of the sidewalks that would have been removed from receiving winter maintenance were in the older highly populated core streets in the City with numerous publically accessible facilities, it was ultimately decided to adjust the Policy and continue to maintain winter maintenance on sidewalks on both sides of approximately fifteen (15) kilometres of streets.

Some streets which were reduced to winter maintenance on sidewalks on one (1) side of streets elected to annually alternate sidewalk maintenance in an effort to appease the local residents. Over the years, the majority of these streets have since been converted to one (1) side only at the request of the local residents supported by the Ward Councillor.

Based on this additional background information, Staff have prepared three (3) Proposed Service Standard Level Options for Council's consideration.

Proposed Option #1: Implement the Official Plan's recommended Winter Maintenance Standard

This Proposed Option would see a consistent service level across the City.

Some streets that have never received winter maintenance will now receive winter service.

Some streets, primarily in the former City which currently receive winter maintenance on both sides of the street will now only receive service on one (1) side of the street, i.e. implement the Policy that the former municipality attempted.

Proposed Option #1 will require an increase in the annual Operating Budget of approximately \$180,000 including a one-time Capital increase of \$250,000 to purchase additional equipment.

If Council approves Proposed Option #1, it is recommended that winter maintenance not be reduced on City streets this winter until after the impacted Ward Councillors have had the opportunity to review each street and meet with residents to determine which side of the street not to maintain or whether alternating winter maintenance is an option.

A list of all sidewalks currently receiving winter maintenance is included in **Appendix 'B'** attached.

A list of additional sidewalks which will receive winter maintenance is included as **Appendix 'C'** attached.

A list of sidewalk which will see winter maintenance eliminated from one (1) side of the street is included in **Appendix 'D'** attached.

Proposed Option #2: Maintain the Existing Winter Maintenance Program and expand service to Official Plan Standards City-wide.

With this Proposed Option, winter maintenance would not be removed from any sidewalk currently receiving service. Sidewalks in the primary outlying communities that have never received winter maintenance will now receive winter maintenance.

This Proposed Option would have the least impact on residents.

Proposed Option #2 will require an increase in the Operating Budget of \$250,000 and a one-time Capital Equipment Budget increase of \$500,000 for additional equipment.

Staff recommends Proposed Option #2 as it is the least disruptive to current service levels and provides service City-wide.

Proposed Option #3: Provide Year-Round Maintenance on All City Sidewalks

Under this Proposed Option, all sidewalks in the City would receive year-round maintenance. The service level on many streets would exceed the recommended Official Plan Standard, and would be the most expensive to implement and maintain.

Proposed Option #3 will require an annual increase in the Operating Budget of \$550,000 and a one-time increase in the Capital Equipment Budget of \$1.5 Million Dollars for additional equipment. Alternatively, Staff will again attempt to select Contractors to provide this service.

3.0 Other Considerations:

Improvement in Service Delivery Time:

Our current, and recommended service level is that all sidewalks be serviced within four (4) to twelve (12) hours for a 'normal' storm and within twenty-four (24) hours during a 'major' storm.

To improve the service delivery by decreasing the service time by fifty percent (50%) i.e. two (2) to six (6) hours for a 'normal' storm and within twelve (12) hours during a 'major' storm, would essentially require doubling the workforce and equipment. A compromise would be to consider providing a mid-level service time to reduce the costs.

It is recommended that once Council determines the sidewalk maintenance standard for the entire City, that Staff return with a total cost estimate for the next years' budget. It is recommended that Staff be given one (1) year to develop, implement and operate the new standard. At that time Staff will be able to provide Council with a more accurate estimate.

In the interim, if Council wishes to decrease the service time by fifty percent (50%) the Operating Budget and equipment requirements will have to be doubled. Historically there have been few Contractors willing to provide winter maintenance for sidewalks. Staff would like the opportunity to investigate the possibility of either leasing the necessary extra equipment required for the winter months or possibly contracting this work to avoid the significant Capital Equipment purchase. Similarly Staff will have to receive additional staff for this option.

Seniors Advisory Panel / Senior Citizens' Concerns:

The issue of snow removal at bus stops has historically been the biggest issue with senior citizens within the City.

With the options presented herein, the existing service level for bus stop snow removal, snow removal along existing roads and service levels in all central business districts will be maintained at current service levels. In general, seniors should see improved service levels in the former outlying municipalities.

Bus Stop Snow Removal:

Snow removal is currently carried out at all 130 bus shelters and 300 of 1500 bus stops, by contractors generally on the second and third nights following a snow storm. The budget for this service is \$50,000.

This work is done by Contractors for two (2) major reasons:

1. at the same time City forces are generally providing clean-up and 'pushing back' operations after the storm and are not available to provide this service, and
2. this work is most efficiently carried out at night when vehicle and pedestrian traffic is minimal.

Depending upon what winter sidewalk service level Council approves, Staff will be able to review our availability to complete some of this work with City crews instead of having to utilize only Contractors.

As a general statement , if Council wishes to remove snow at all 1500 bus stops, the existing budget would have to be increased to \$200,000.

Pathways and Walkways:

It is proposed that all pathways and walkways currently receiving winter maintenance or those which form an integral part of our pedestrian sidewalk system will receive winter maintenance. There are numerous footpaths and walkways within each local community which may or may not form part of this integrated sidewalk system. It is recommended that no decision on expanding winter maintenance to these walkways be decided at this time. It is recommended that Staff meet with each Ward Councillor over the course of this winter to discuss each specific pathway / walkway taking into consideration the specific wishes of each local neighbourhood.

A cost estimate to add in these extra pathways / walkways will be identified if required in future years.

A service issue which will have to be addressed at each location is the significant potential for usage of the walkways by snow machines and all-wheel vehicles on a twenty-four (24) hour, seven (7) days per week basis.

As discussed with Council in May 2008, all walkways / pathways within parks that solely service the parks will remain the sole responsibility of the Parks Division and are beyond the scope of this report.

Recommendation:

Staff recommend that Council approve Proposed Option #2 of the Winter Sidewalk Maintenance Standard and Service Level report from the General Manager of Infrastructure Services dated October 20, 2008 and that Staff be directed to bring forward to the 2009 Budget a permanent Operations Budget Option in the amount of \$250,000 and a one-time Capital Equipment Budget Option of \$500,000.

Introduction

- Council has requested staff to prepare Winter Sidewalk Maintenance Options for their consideration.
- Staff have reviewed options and prior to committing resources to investigate those options further, staff is looking for Council's direction.

This presentation provides Council With:

- A background on Winter Sidewalk Maintenance
- Current Service Level
- Issues impacting Winter Sidewalk Maintenance
- Potential options for Council's consideration

Background

- Winter sidewalk maintenance has been maintained at service levels that existed pre-amalgamation.
- Former Councils established service levels via By-Laws.
 - There is disparity in which sidewalks have or have not been designated for Winter Maintenance Service between the former municipalities.
 - The level of sidewalk maintenance provided is the same for all sidewalks designated for winter maintenance, with the exception of the old City of Sudbury business core which receives service five (5) times per week from Sunday midnight to Friday 8 a.m.

Official Plan

Section 11.7 of the CGS Official Plan

- Sidewalks facilitate active living and are an essential component of good neighbourhood design, providing a safe pedestrian environment and access to other transportation linkages such as transit stops and trails. Curbs and sidewalks in neighbourhoods also encourage walking and provide safety for children. It is a policy of this Plan to provide the following on new and reconstructed roads, when feasible:
 - a) Sidewalks on both sides of urban Arterial Roads and Collector Roads adjacent to developed lands;
 - b) Sidewalks on at least one side of Local Roads;
 - c) High quality pedestrian connections to transit;
 - d) Pedestrian connections between neighbourhoods; and
 - e) Pedestrian linkages to major attractions/generators.

Current Service Level

Winter Maintenance


- The current service level requires response to winter conditions at 8 cm or icy conditions by plowing, snow blowing and/or sanding designated sidewalks within 4 to 24 hours following the end of a winter event.
- Council reviewed this service level and reaffirmed it in 2006. Therefore, no change is proposed.

Equipment


- A specialized Municipal Tractor (MT) is used with plow, snow blower and sander attachments to provide winter service to sidewalks. These machines with winter attachments cost approximately \$150,000.
- The MT's are designed to work on the standard 1.5 metre sidewalk, but also have other attachments to allow them to be used for other tasks such as mowing, grinding, brushing, asphalt repair and spraying.

Issues

- No provincial minimum maintenance standards
- Movement of pedestrians in winter
- Liability – regardless if sidewalk is maintained
- Difference in sidewalks designated for service across City (Falconbridge / Levack).
- Additional Snow Removal
 - Availability of snow storage area
 - Increased snow removal costs
- Arterial / Collectors
 - Sidewalks adjacent to these roads require more frequent servicing to maintain standard with limited space for snow storage.

Challenges

- Some Existing Sidewalks are Designed Too Small to Safely Accommodate MT's
 - 1.2 metres wide
 - Splash pads(can not safely accommodate sidewalk equipment)
- Location
 - Snow storage for property owners
- Walking Paths
 - Restricted access to motorized vehicles
- No Sidewalks
 - Require Capital Plan and Expenditures

Options

1. Adopt Official Plan (Yes or No)
 - Two (2) side arterial / collector
 - One (1) side residential
 - Rebuilding roads to Official Plan
 - Eliminate one (1) existing sidewalk on streets with two (2) sidewalks

Options

2. Maintain Substandard Sidewalks

- a) Where standard equipment can not be used (Yes or No).
- b) Where it is not continuous with existing system (Yes or No).

Options

3. Service Provided by Property Owners (Yes or No)
 - Budget reduction
 - Impact on seniors
 - Enforcement
 - Other municipalities , Ad Hoc
