2007/2008 Approved Winter Service Level

 24/7 Winter Coverage on all Roads

 All roads plowed 16 to 24 hours following end of storm









2007/2008 Approved Winter Service Level

- City Crews respond on Class 1-3 Roads
- Contractors supplement City crews at 8 cm. of snow accumulation on all Class 4-6 Roads
- All sidewalks plowed within 24 hours following end of storm
- Contractor standby ends April 15,2008







2007/2008 Winter Season

- Total Snowfall
 - Actual 189 cm.
 - Normal 206 cm. (30 yr. Avg.)
- 82 Events to Feb. 29, 2008
 - 19 General Callouts of all Contractors for snowfalls of greater than or equal to 8 cm. or freezing rain events
 - Ice/Slippery Road Conditions with City Crews spot sanding hills, curves, intersections and sidewalks







2007/2008 Winter Season

- One route exceeded the 24 hour response time
 - required redesign
 - addition of one extra grader route
- Response times for 4x4 units used for clearing lanes and cul-de-sacs was too long
 - -1 additional 4x4 unit added to improve service





2007/2008 Winter Season

- Spare City Units and unscheduled Contractor
 Units available to ramp up for major storm events
- Internal Qualified Operators Utilized from other Departments
- City and Contractor Units have worked together to plow rural and residential Class 4 to 6 routes resulting in reducing service time to 12 to 18 hours for storm events this year

Winter Maintenance Operations Update



Challenges

- Extreme weather fluctuations has resulted in:
 - increased use of sand/salt
 - an increase in the number of potholes
- During extended storm events requiring overtime, occasional use of Contractors was required to maintain main salt routes – Class 1 to 3

Winter Maintenance Operations Update









Conclusion

- Only 3 major storms
- Increased salt and sand usage as a result of icy events and freeze/thaw cycles
- Increased number of potholes because of weather conditions
- The number of complaints received has decreased over the winter from 428 season start to 59 last storm event.
