Report Summary

This report outlines the nomination process for the Nominating Committee to appoint citizens to fill the vacancies on the City of Greater Sudbury Advisory Panels.

Background

As outlined in the report regarding the appointment of citizens to Advisory Panels that was presented at the Nominating Committee meeting on February 5, 2019, the deadline to apply for the following Advisory Panels was extended to Friday, February 1, 2019 at 4:30 p.m.:

In addition, the Communications Department issued two (2) PSAs advertising the extension. A sufficient number of completed application forms have now been received to fill the vacant positions. Citizens who had already submitted an application to sit on the above noted Panels were not required to apply again.

Public Art Advisory Panel
