By-law 2021-27

A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Close Part of Unopened Dufferin Street in Sudbury Described as PIN 02135-0260(LT)

Whereas in accordance with the provisions of Section 34 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, the Council of every municipality may pass by-laws for permanently closing a highway or part of a highway;

And Whereas Council of the City of Greater Sudbury deems it desirable that a by-law be passed closing that part of unopened Dufferin Street in Sudbury legally described PIN 02135-0260, being Part of Dufferin Street, Block B, Plan 3SA Lying South of Canadian Pacific Railway, East of College Street (Formerly Lorne Street) and North of Pine Street, City of Sudbury;

Now therefore Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That part of unopened Dufferin Street in Sudbury legally described PIN 02135-0260, being Part of Dufferin Street, Block B, Plan 3SA Lying South of Canadian Pacific Railway, East of College Street (Formerly Lorne Street) and North of Pine Street, City of Sudbury is hereby permanently closed.
- 2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect when registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Registry Division of Sudbury (No. 53) pursuant to Section 34 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001.
- 3. By-law 2020-188, being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Close Part of the Unopened Dufferin Street in Sudbury Described PIN 02135-0260, Being Part of Block B, Plan 3SA is hereby repealed.
