

We have engaged in a \$4.2 million 3-year retrofit program

These items include:

- a new roof,
- upgrading of our heating, ventilation and air conditioning units,
- windows,
- beds and mattresses,
- kitchen equipment including new industrial ovens,
- bathroom equipment including new therapeutic tubs, and
- blanket warmers

The repairs will result in a safer, more comfortable and secure home for our residents, staff, volunteers and families.





Our History

In 1950, the Sisters of St. Joseph of Sault Ste. Marie built and opened the first English hospital, the Sudbury General Hospital of the Immaculate Heart of Mary on Paris Street, most recently known as St. Joseph's Health Centre (SJHC), opened as the first English speaking hospital in Sudbury. In 1972 the facility;

- went from 200 to 360 beds providing the majority of acute care beds in the area.
- gradually expanded to provide a full range of health care services to the community.





Early 2000's to 2011

Following the Health Services Restructuring Commission directives (at which time the Sisters exited the healthcare system), St. Joseph's Health Centre

- Responded to the unmet needs in the community and applied for new long-term care beds that were available in Ontario and built St. Joseph's Villa.
- Worked with the Ministry of Health in moving the non-acute continuing care program out of HRSRH (HSN) to the St. Joseph's Continuing Care Centre site as a cost saving measure and to assist the acute hospital to restart its construction project.





Current Overview

St. Joseph's Health Centre now oversees the operation of the Village of Care Campus located on South Bay Road.

- Holds licences and mortgages for St. Joseph's Villa (SJV),
 a 128-bed long-term care home and Villa St. Gabriel Villa (VSGV),
 a 128-bed long-term care home located in Chelmsford.
- Operates St. Joseph's Continuing Care Centre (SJCCC), a 64-bed complex continuing care hospital, classified as a "G" and "E" hospital under the Ministry of Health. Opened and operates 60 additional beds at the Clarion Hotel in response to capacity issues in our community due to COVID-19.





St. Joseph's Villa opened December 1, 2003

- 4 neighbourhoods with 32 residents each
 - Gardenway is our dementia care unit
 - Other neighbourhoods include Lakeview, Sunnyside and Hillcrest

Villa St. Gabriel Villa opened March 28, 2011

- 4 neighbourhoods with 32 residents each similar to SJV
- \$2M was received from the City of Greater Sudbury for the Villa St. Gabriel Villa build






