By-law 2021-04

A By-Law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Authorize the Payment of a Grant from the Healthy Community Initiative Fund, Ward 7

Whereas pursuant to Section 107 of the *Municipal Act 2001*, S.O. 2001 c. 25, Council may pass by-laws for grants to certain bodies for purposes in the interest of the municipality;

And Whereas Council of the City of Greater Sudbury allocated from the capital envelope, in the year 2021, sums for expenditures from the Healthy Community Initiative Fund in accordance with By-law 2018-129 being A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Adopt a Policy Regarding the Healthy Community Initiative Fund;

And Whereas Council of the City of Greater Sudbury wishes to authorize the making of a certain grant in accordance with the guidelines as set out in By-law 2018-129 being A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Adopt a Policy Regarding the Healthy Community Initiative Fund;

Now therefore Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

- Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby approves the payment of up to \$700.00 by way of grant, from the Healthy Community Initiative Fund to Lake Wahnapitae Home & Campers Association as a contribution to support the Lake Safety Program (Spring 2021). This is a one time grant.
- 2. The Treasurer is hereby authorized to make the payment from the Healthy Community Initiative Fund, Ward 7 Grants and Donations to Community Groups allocation upon the written request of the General Manager of Community Development or such person as he may have authorized to request funds in his place and stead. The General Manager of Community Development is authorized to execute on behalf of the City, any agreement with a grant recipient setting out the terms of the grant.
- 3. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon passage.
