By-law 2021-06

A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Authorize an Agreement with Atikameksheng Anishnawbek First Nation

Whereas the City of Greater Sudbury has been providing potable water to the former Whitefish Lake Indian Reserve No. 6, as represented by the Whitefish Lake Band Council, now Atikameksheng Anishnawbek First Nation (AAFN) pursuant to an agreement between the parties;

And Whereas AAFN has undertaken the construction of a wastewater collection system to serve an industrial park being created on their lands, but does not have the capacity to treat the wastewater;

And Whereas the AAFN has requested that the City accept the wastewater from its wastewater collection system for treatment at the Walden wastewater treatment plant;

And Whereas AAFN has further requested the City's assistance to monitor and provide certain maintenance services and other assistance regarding their wastewater collection system;

Now therefore Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

1-(1) The General Manager of Growth and Infrastructure is hereby authorized to negotiate and sign, on behalf of the City of Greater Sudbury, an agreement with Atikameksheng Anishnawbek First Nation (AAFN), setting out the terms and conditions on which the City will accept wastewater from the AAFN wastewater collection system, and specifying the services and other assistance which the City will provide with respect to the ongoing operation of the AAFN wastewater collection system.

(2) The General Manager of Infrastructure is further authorized to negotiate and execute any subsequent amendments, renewals or extensions and any other related documents, and to make all decisions and perform all functions required pursuant to the agreement in order to administer and implement the terms of the agreement.
