








New Sidewalks

Design and Construction of Paris-Notre Dame Bikeway

- Engineering design completed in early 2020
- 1.6 km segment on Notre Dame Ave (Wilma St to LaSalle Blvd) complete





Pilot Project – Right-turn Channel Crossing Treatment



Yield Sign	 Used to indicate that all approaching vehicles must yield to crossing traffic
TO	 Placed at a crossing within a channelized right-turn lane to instruct motorists to yield to crossing pedestrians and cyclists Accompanies a yield sign
