

By-law 2020-142

A By-Law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Amend By-Law 2006-280 being a By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury Dealing with the Collection, Removal, and Disposal of Waste within the City of Greater Sudbury

Whereas the City of Greater Sudbury wishes to amend By-law 2006-280 being a By-Law of the City of Greater Sudbury Dealing with the Collection, Removal and Disposal of Waste with the City of Greater Sudbury, as amended;

Now therefore Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

Add Subsection 7(3A)

1. By-law 2006-280 being a By-Law of the City of Greater Sudbury Dealing with the Collection, Removal and Disposal of Waste with the City of Greater Sudbury, as amended, is further amended by enacting the following subsection 7(3A) immediately after subsection 7(3) and before subsection 7(4):

“(3A) Despite Subsection 7(2), waste collection service for garbage will be provided in excess of the limits established in subsection 7(2), in accordance with a support program approved by Council for the City which provides for collection in excess of the limits in subsection 7(2).”

Add Subsection 11(1A)


2. By-law 2006-280 being a By-Law of the City of Greater Sudbury Dealing with the Collection, Removal and Disposal of Waste with the City of Greater Sudbury, as amended, is further amended by enacting the following subsection 11(1A) immediately after subsection 11(1) and before subsection 11(2):

“11(1A) Despite clause 11(1)(a)(i), effective as of January 31st, 2021, waste collection services for garbage may be provided more frequently, but not more often than weekly, where the General Manager has approved an application for more frequent collection in accordance with the terms of a support program approved by Council for the City which allows for more frequent collection.”


