## By-law 2020-127

A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Close Part of Unopened Road Allowance North of Maki Avenue in Sudbury Described as PIN 73594-0435(LT) and Part of PIN 73594-0417(LT), being Parts 1 to 6 on Plan 53R-21350

Whereas in accordance with the provisions of Section 34 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, the Council of every municipality may pass by-laws for permanently closing a highway or part of a highway;

And Whereas Council of the City of Greater Sudbury deems it desirable that a by-law be passed closing that part of unopened road allowance, north of Maki Avenue in Sudbury legally described PIN 73594-0435(LT) and Part of PIN 73594-0417(LT), being Parts 1–6 on Plan 53R-21350, Township of McKim, City of Greater Sudbury;

## Now therefore Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That part of unopened road allowance, north of Maki Avenue in Sudbury legally described as PIN 73594-0435(LT) and Part of PIN 73594-0417(LT), being Parts 1–6 on Plan 53R-21350, Township of McKim, City of Greater Sudbury is hereby permanently closed.
- 2. This By-law shall come into force and take effect when registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Registry Division of Sudbury (No. 53) pursuant to Section 34 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001.
