

By-law 2020-92

**A By-law of the City of Greater Sudbury to Authorize Certain
Grants for the Transportation Demand Management Community Grant Program**

Whereas pursuant to Section 107 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 Council may pass by-laws for grants to certain bodies for purposes in the interest of the City;

And Whereas in June, 2018 Council for the City of Greater Sudbury adopted the Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Plan for the City which outlines an approach for the City to deliver programs and initiatives to complement infrastructure delivery for transit, walking and cycling;

And Whereas Council of the City of Greater Sudbury has approved a a Transportation Demand Management (TDM) Community Grant Program for the purpose of providing grants to eligible non-profit organizations to assist with community-based activities that have a positive city-wide impact and support implementation of the TDM Plan for Greater Sudbury and allocated funds for such purpose;

And Whereas application for grants under the 2020 allocation of funds for the TDM Community Grant Program were submitted, and reviewed in accordance with the TDM Community Grant Program Handbook and recommendations made to Council;

And Whereas Council of the City of Greater Sudbury wishes to make grants to various non-profit groups pursuant to such recommendations:

Now therefore Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby enacts as follows:

1. Council of the City of Greater Sudbury hereby authorizes the making of a grant pursuant to the TDM Community Grant Program, up to the amount specified in Column B of Schedule "A" attached hereto to the non-profit organization identified in Column A of the corresponding row in Schedule "A" for use by the named grantee for the purposes described in Column C of Schedule "A" and in accordance with the approved application submitted by that grantee, to achieve the goals of the TDM Plan for the City of Greater Sudbury.
2. The General Manager of Growth and Infrastructure is hereby authorized to execute any agreement, amendment or other related documents necessary to set out the terms on which the grant will be provided.


3. The Treasurer may advance all or part of each such grant at such time or from time to time, as may be requested in writing by the General Manager of Growth and Infrastructure from the funds allocated to the TDM Community Grant Program.

4. This is a one-time grant.

5. Schedule "A" is incorporated into and forms a part of this By-law.

6. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon passage.
