Policies and Plans:

Complete Streets Policy

- ▶ City Council approved the Complete Streets Policy in July 2018
- ▶ The 6th municipality in Ontario to adopt a formal policy
- ▶ Complete Streets Design Guidelines included within the recommended 2019 Capital Budget



Policies and Plans:

Transportation Demand Management Plan

- ▶ Approved by City Council in June 2018
- ▶ Recommends 23 initiatives, policies and programs to complement infrastructure delivery
- ▶ A Business Case has been prepared for the 2019 Budget process for annual operating funding for implementation



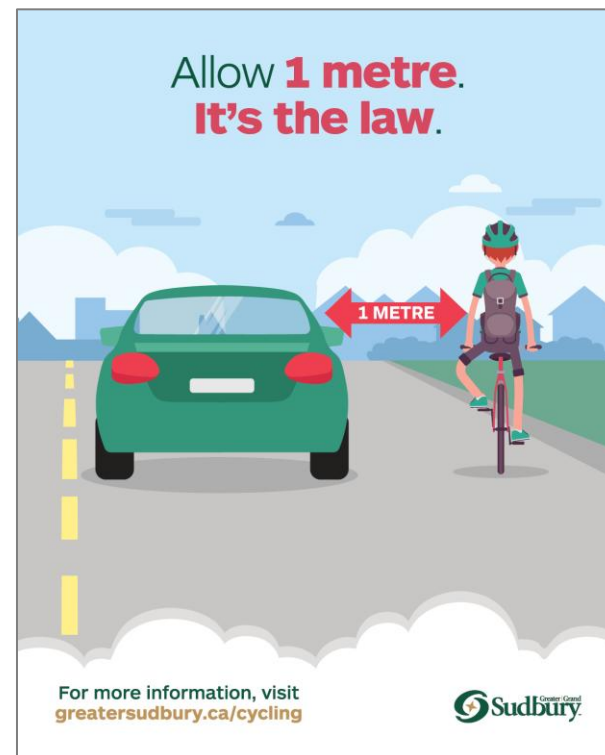

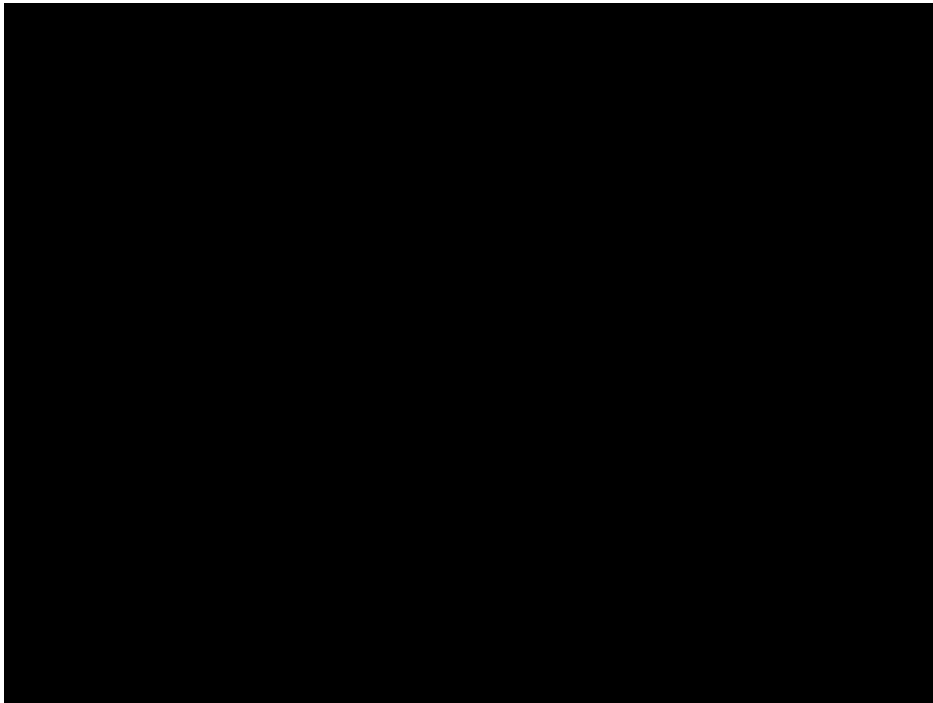
